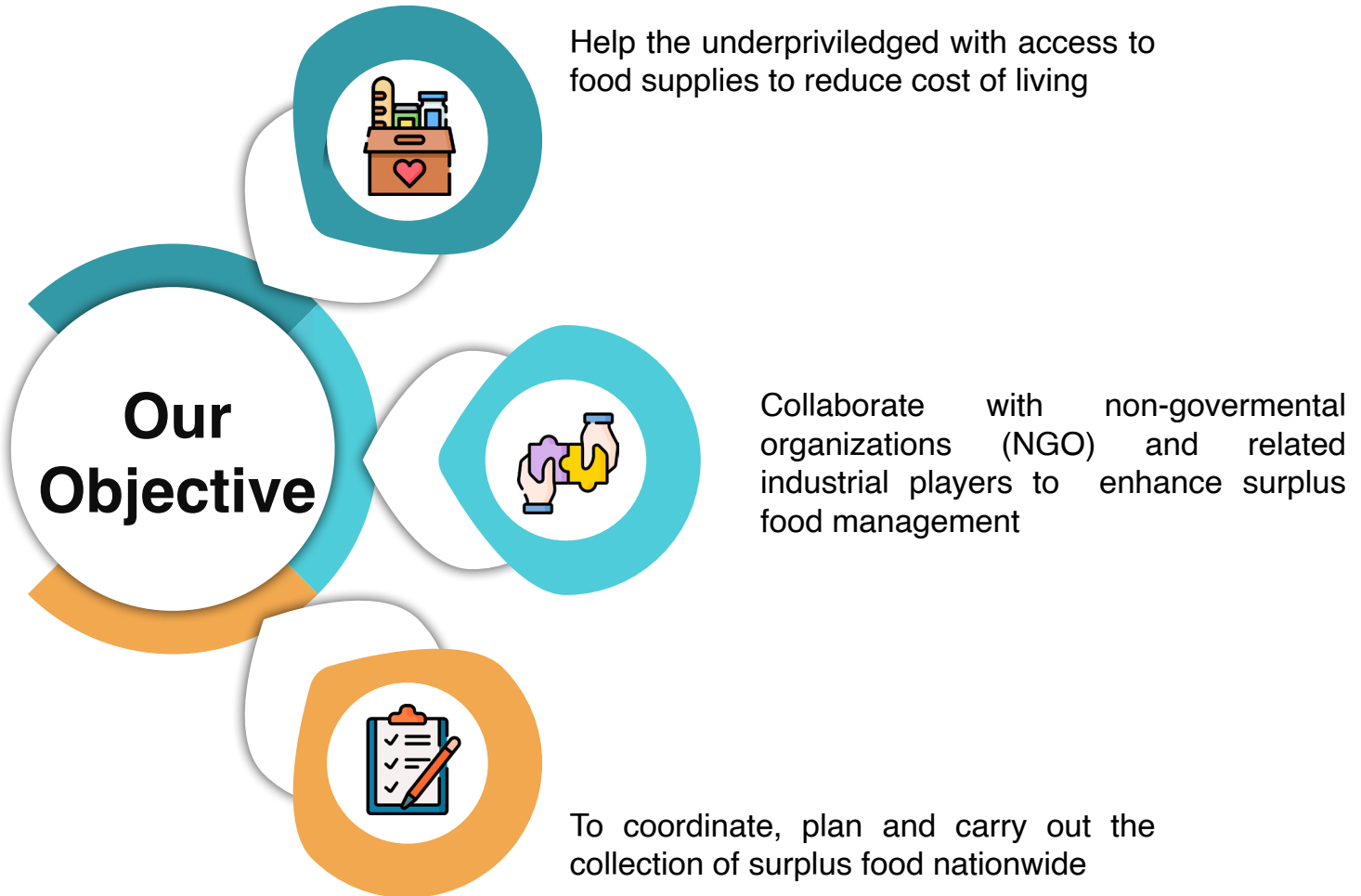

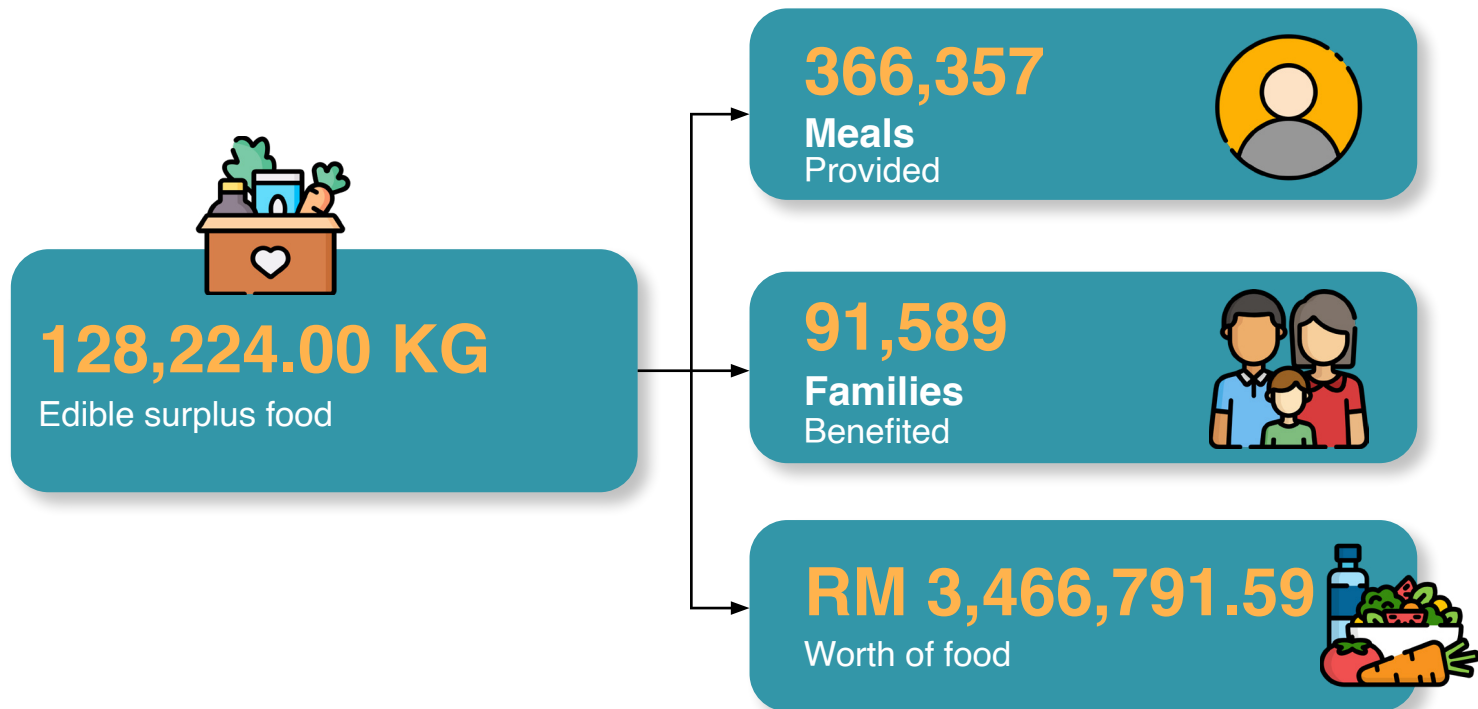


G GOVERNANCE

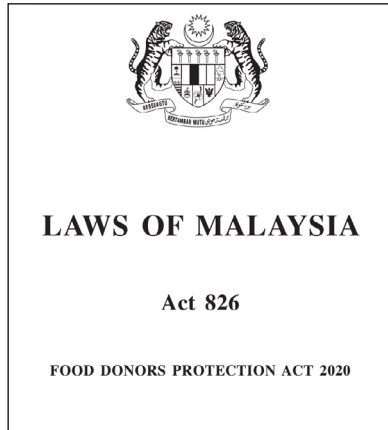

FOOD DONORS PROTECTION ACT 2020



The Food Donors Protection Act have been gazetted on 10 February 2020 which gives protection to food donors from civil liability.

PROTECTION OF FOOD DONORS

A food donor shall not be liable for any civil liability against any personal injury, or illness suffered by any person or the death of any such person resulting from consumption of food donated or distributed by food donors unless it can be proven that :



The food donor does not comply with any requirement in relation to food safety and hygiene under any written law before donating or distributing the food



Personal injury, illness or death caused by negligence or willful misconduct by food donors



The food is not safe to be eaten at the time the food is donated or distributed to any person



Donations and distribution of food are not made of good faith

After making a donation to us, save proof of payment either through a screenshot or a pdf file. Proof of payment is important for us to review the donation transaction that has been made.

FILL THE FORM

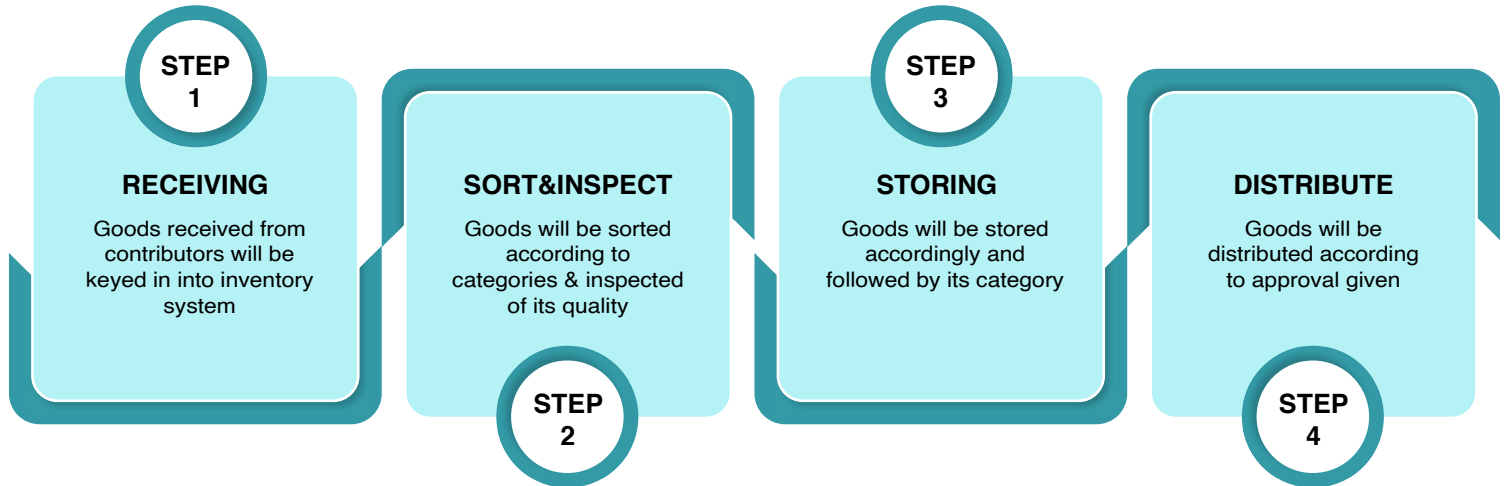
To claim a tax exemption receipt, you need to fill out a tax exemption application form which can be found on our website. You can claim these receipts individually or as an organization. Upload proof of payment made while filling this form.

04

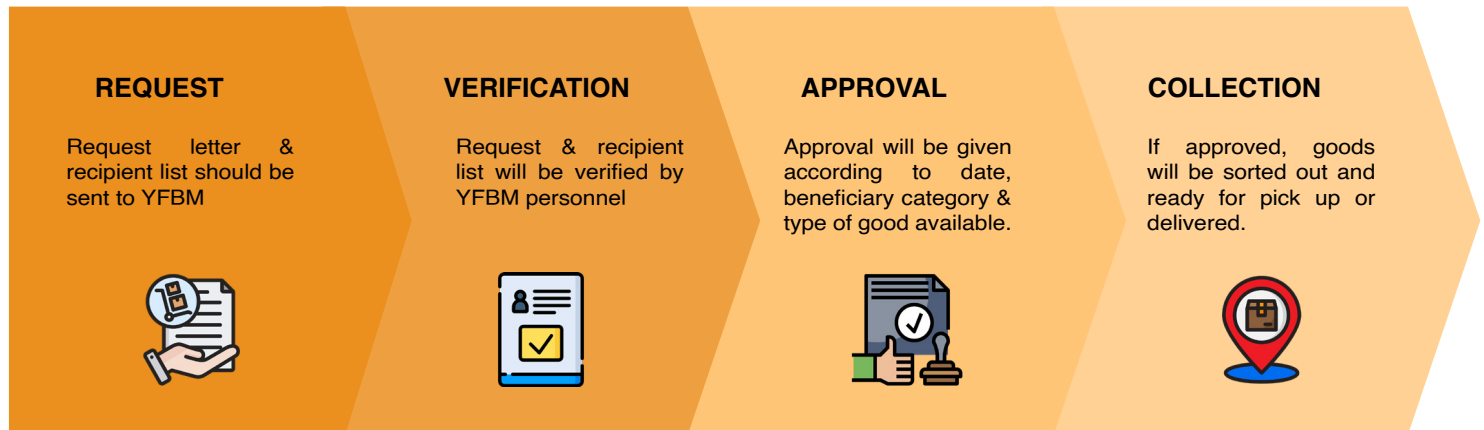
RECEIVING

PROGRAMS ACTIVITIES IN 2023

Food Bank Komuniti

Collaboration program with Corporates or Individuals to support selected communities with food banking centre (6 month program)

Food Bank Lestari

A program that is carried out in a certain period in collaboration with government or private agencies that contribute on a large scale for a certain period. Food Bank Lestari focuses on the poor, B40 and the homeless.

Food Bank Cares

The Food Bank Cares program collaborates with corporate agencies to provide surplus food to charity homes, addressing hunger and fostering community involvement.

Food Bank Hot Meals

Collaboration program with corporates, groups or individuals to provide hot meals for charity homes communities in need.

Kembara Tengkujuh

Yayasan Food Bank Malaysia aims to assist rubber tappers' communities and Orang Asli and communities from fishing villages who have lost income during the monsoon season in several identified states.

Kembara Merdeka

Kembara Merdeka, a program initiated by Yayasan Food Bank Malaysia, is designed to cultivate a strong sense of patriotism among Malaysians while inspiring them to extend a helping hand to communities experiencing economic adversity. Through this initiative, participants are encouraged to embrace the values of compassion and solidarity by assisting those in dire need.

Food Bank Runcit

Requested by individual directly to all YFBM media platform. YFBM will deliver through Volunteer (Public, Media, Public Figure & NGOs)

Food Bank Relief

The purpose is to help victims of disasters such as floods, fires, landslides and other disasters that result in the loss of property.

Box of Hope - Pengurusan Air Selangor

Box of Hope is a program under Food Bank Cares that is in collaboration and fully funded by Pengurusan Air Selangor to provide box of packaged foods, dry goods and basic necessities to communities in need.

Kelas Rimba Bateq 1.0

Kelas Rimba Bateq is a program that provides education to children of the Bateq people, which is part of the indigenous people in Malaysia. The program focused on reading and writing, personal hygiene and physical education.
